FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

WHO CAN APPLY?

- > We are looking for staff, both male and female, ages 19+ who have skills and experience in one of the activities we offer our campers. Please refer to the Employment page for the most current positions available. We prefer applicants with some teaching experience. We also hire individuals who are willing to learn to teach children.
- > We are seeking dynamic, fun and patient individuals who are interested in sharing their talents and working with us in a rustic environment! Please read our [job descriptions](#) for more information on specific activities.



WHAT WILL I BE DOING?

- > From Monday-Saturday, you will be teaching your activity to all age groups, ranging from 7-17 years old. Activity teaching periods run for 2 hours in the morning and 2 hours in the afternoon. Sundays are a relaxed day with no scheduled activities.
- > Your day will also involve being a lodge counselor. This includes getting your campers up in the morning, helping them with lodge clean-up as well as some rest hour duty, putting your campers to bed in the evenings and some night duty.
- > Each day you will have a portion of time off to go for a run, take a shower, check your email, etc. In the evenings, once your campers are in bed, you will also enjoy some free time. Everyone has one day off a week, plus other time off throughout your contract.



WHERE WILL I BE LIVING?

- > Female staff will live with a co-counselor and their campers in rustic but comfortable summer cabins. Male staff will share with one other person. Washrooms and showers are nearby.
- > Counselors will sleep in a single bed and will be provided with a nightstand and storage for your personal belongings. Some lodges have electricity and washrooms, and some do not. All cabins have front porches to gather on with views of the lake! Male staff live in cabins off limits to campers.
- > We have a central shower house with lots of hot water, and washrooms are within a few steps of the lodges. Camp Arcadia has a laundry room for staff use, as well as areas where counselors can spend their free time. Our counselor room is equipped with wireless Internet. Cell phone use is permitted in designated areas of Camp.
